## **2. Purpose of Collaboration**

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a cooperative relationship in areas that may include:

- ▶ Student exchange programmes

- ▶ Research collaboration
- ▶ Joint training and workshops
- ▶ International consultancy
- ▶ Professional certification programmes
- ▶ Capacity building initiatives
- ▶ Conferences and seminars
- ▶ Global networking opportunities

Both parties agree to work collaboratively toward shared educational and professional objectives.

## **3. Scope of Collaboration**

Collaboration under this MoU may include, but is not limited to:

### **Academic Cooperation**

- ▶ Joint educational initiatives
- ▶ Curriculum development support
- ▶ Collaborative learning activities
- ▶ International programme promotion

### **Student Engagement**

- ▶ Student mobility and exchange opportunities
- ▶ Internship and placement initiatives
- ▶ Cross-cultural educational activities
- ▶ Scholarship and progression pathways

### **Faculty & Staff Collaboration**

- ▶ Faculty exchange programmes
- ▶ Professional development training
- ▶ Academic mentoring and workshops
- ▶ Joint conferences and seminars

### **Research & Innovation**

- ▶ Joint research projects
  - ▶ Publication opportunities
  - ▶ Innovation and technology initiatives
  - ▶ Research networking activities

## 4. Responsibilities of EduIntl

EduIntl agrees to:

- ▶ Provide partnership coordination and support
- ▶ Facilitate communication between collaborating parties
- ▶ Support programme planning and implementation
- ▶ Promote collaborative initiatives where appropriate
- ▶ Maintain professional operational standards
- ▶ Assist with partnership onboarding processes
- ▶ Provide guidance regarding compliance and documentation

---

## 5. Responsibilities of the Partner Institution

The partner institution agrees to:

- ▶ Provide accurate institutional information
- ▶ Maintain professional and ethical standards
- ▶ Comply with applicable laws and regulations
- ▶ Participate actively in collaborative initiatives
- ▶ Designate authorised representatives for communication
- ▶ Support quality assurance procedures
- ▶ Respect partnership policies and operational frameworks

---

## 6. Financial Arrangements

Unless otherwise agreed in writing:

- ▶ Each party shall bear its own operational costs
- ▶ Financial obligations for specific programmes may be addressed separately
- ▶ Joint projects requiring funding may involve additional agreements
- ▶ No financial liability shall arise unless formally approved by both parties

---

## 7. Confidentiality

Both parties agree to:

- ▶ Protect confidential information shared during collaboration
- ▶ Avoid unauthorised disclosure of sensitive materials
- ▶ Use shared information solely for partnership purposes
- ▶ Maintain professional confidentiality standards

Confidentiality obligations shall continue even after termination of the agreement where applicable.

## 8. Intellectual Property

Any educational materials, branding, research outputs, or intellectual property developed jointly may be subject to separate agreements.

Neither party may:

- ▶ Misuse the branding or identity of the other party

- ▶ Reproduce proprietary materials without permission
  - ▶ Claim ownership of jointly developed resources without agreement

## 9. Compliance & Legal Obligations

Both parties agree to comply with:

- ▶ National and international educational regulations
- ▶ Data protection and privacy laws
- ▶ Ethical academic and business standards
- ▶ Immigration and visa-related requirements where applicable
- ▶ Institutional governance and compliance procedures

Any legal or regulatory concerns affecting the partnership must be communicated promptly.

---

## 10. Duration of Agreement

This MoU shall remain valid for a mutually agreed period unless terminated earlier by either party in accordance with the termination clause.

The agreement may be renewed, amended, or extended upon written consent from both parties.

---

## 11. Amendment Procedures

This MoU may be modified or amended only through written agreement signed by authorised representatives of both parties.

Any additional collaborative activities may require supplementary agreements or annexures.

---

## 12. Termination

Either party may terminate this MoU by providing written notice to the other party.

Termination may occur in cases involving:

- ▶ Breach of agreement
- ▶ Non-compliance with policies
- ▶ Fraudulent or unethical conduct
- ▶ Operational or legal concerns
- ▶ Mutual agreement to discontinue collaboration

Termination shall not affect obligations already agreed upon prior to termination unless otherwise specified.

---

## 13. Dispute Resolution

Both parties agree to resolve disputes amicably through communication and mutual consultation wherever possible.

Where necessary, disputes may be addressed in accordance with applicable legal and regulatory frameworks.

## 14. Non-Binding Nature

Unless otherwise stated in separate legally binding agreements, this MoU represents a statement of mutual cooperation intentions and does not create legally enforceable financial or contractual obligations.

Specific operational, financial, or programme arrangements may require additional agreements.

## 15. Signatures & Authorisation

By signing this Memorandum of Understanding, both parties acknowledge that they have reviewed, understood, and agreed to the terms outlined in this document.
